## SOPS FOR CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING, CORU OR ANY VERIFICATIONS

Practitioners who need a Certificate of Good Standing (COGS) or any other external verifications (CORU, ECFMG, DATAFLOW) should adhere to the following procedures.

## 1. Application requirements

Consistent with the Medical Practitioners and Dentists Act and Regulations, the practitioner:

- Should be registered with the MCM
- o Should not have outstanding fees, fines, penalties.
- Should not have criminal convictions
- o Provide proof of payment.

## 2. Application process

 Submit a written application for the type of request (COGS, CORU, ECFMG, DATAFLOW) and attach relevant documents. Application can be submitted online (medcom@medcommw.org) or in person at MCM offices.

## Application should include;

- Full name, postal address and registration number of practitioner (as indicate on the registration certificate).
- Proof of payment of relevant fees (refer to fee schedule). Currently, K85,000 for local practitioners and 200 USD/Kwacha equivalent for international practitioners).
- O Details or any relevant details of where the document should be sent (courier or electronically through email).
- The practitioner will have to pay courier fees where the documents are sent through courier.
- 3. The processing time is 5 working days upon meeting all the requirements
- 4. The COGS is valid for 6 months from the date of issue.
