PRE-INTERNSHIP EXAMINATIONS FOR INTERN MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS TRAINED OUTSIDE OF MALAWI

The Medical Council of Malawi (MCM) was established through the Medical Practitioners and Dentists (MPD) Act of 1987. It is mandated to regulate medical, dental and allied health practitioners, health higher training institutions, and health facilities to protect the public. In alignment with its mandate, the MCM is pleased to announce that the pre-internship examinations for prospective Intern Medical Practitioners trained outside the country are scheduled as follows:

Venue: Malawi College of Health Sciences (Lilongwe Campus)

Dates: 16th April and 17th April

Time: 7:30 am (on both days)

All eligible candidates are hereby requested to confirm their availability by submitting all required documents, and making necessary payments by **7th April 2026 at 4:30pm**. Only candidates who fulfil requirements will be allowed to sit for the examinations. The examinations will be conducted physically without an online option.

Fees are as follows:

Malawian nationals - **MK400,000**

Non-Malawian nationals - **750 USD**.
